Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the Post-Secondary Institution upon receipt of Scholarship Recipient Form, which is completed by the Student and/or Counselor. Student must send Recipient form and verification of enrollment by August 1st for fall semester, December 1st for spring semester, and April 1st for summer semester to CFCC or scholarship monies will be forfeited
